


# Safety over EtherCAT®

## Successful EtherCAT Interoperability Testing Week in Japan

With the recently concluded EtherCAT Interoperability Testing Week in Japan, the EtherCAT Technology Group brings this year’s series of developer events in online format to a close. As in the other countries, the first event of this kind in Japan was very well received by the participants. More than 60 interested developers of EtherCAT products participated in a total of ten sessions spread over the week, during which the optimal use of the tools offered by ETG as well as new device profiles for the semiconductor industry were discussed. During the sessions, ETG’s experts presented corresponding solutions in a practice-oriented manner, which met with a very positive response from the participants. It was particularly well received that the team around Masanori Obata, head of ETG’s Japan office, had also prepared the presentation content in Japanese. Guido Beckmann, who

attended the EtherCAT Interoperability Testing Week as Chairman of the ETG Technical Committee, summarized the event as follows: “The plenary webinars as well as the individual expert sessions showed us that this event format is a good opportunity to exchange knowledge and ideas, to enter into discussion with developers and thus to make EtherCAT technology and its interoperability even better.” For the coming year, in addition to the newly established online offerings for developers, a physical EtherCAT Plug Fest is again planned in Japan.
